- The CMS value-based modifier program will be discussed in a webinar Tuesday, March 18, from 11 a.m. to noon CT. Starting in 2015, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will begin applying a value modifier under the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (MPFS), as mandated by the Affordable Care Act, with all eligible professionals (EPs) phased in by 2017. Patrick Hamilton, CMS Region III health insurance specialist, will offer participants reasons for the VM program, mechanisms for reporting, and the process for determining the VM payment.
